Resolution approving Agreement for Connection of 4300 Merle Hay Road to the City Sewer System.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Agreement for Connection of 4300 Merle Hay Road to the City Sewer System.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City of Des Moines has received a request from Vista Two Partners, LLC., to obtain sewer service to the property it owns at 4300 Merle Hay Road in the City of Urbandale from the public sewer system operated by the City of Des Moines. Vista Two Partners, LLC has agreed to the terms and conditions set forth in the proposed agreement and covenant regarding sewer service outside Des Moines City limits. This proposed agreement will allow the immediate provision of City sewer service to the property.

The City Manager recommends that such service be provided upon the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement and covenant regarding sewer service outside Des Moines City limits.

The property at 4300 Merle Hay is located upon a portion of the former site of the Bob Brown Chevrolet Dealership which previously obtained sewer service from the City of Des Moines. The property is proposed to be redeveloped with a Discount Tire business and the City of Urbandale is unable to provide sewer service to this property. The business shall pay an initial connection fee of \$2,055.58 to connect to the City of Des Moines sewer system and shall pay ongoing charges for sewer service under this agreement equal to twice the schedule of rates applicable to those properties located within the corporate limits of the City of Des Moines.
