**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for resurfacing E. Euclid Avenue (U.S. 6) from York Street to Hubbell Avenue and E. 14th St. (U.S. 69) from E. Ovid Avenue to E. Fleming Avenue.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of IDOT Agreement No. 2016-6-016 for resurfacing E. Euclid Avenue (U.S. 6) from York Street to Hubbell Avenue and E. 14th Street (U.S. 69) from E. Ovid Avenue to E. Fleming Avenue. The IDOT will construct the hot mix asphalt resurfacing utilizing IDOT funds, at an estimated cost of approximately \$1,100,000. The City will only be responsible for the costs of sanitary and storm sewer manhole adjustments and spot replacement of curb and gutter, estimated to be \$21,465.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The IDOT has determined that it is necessary to install three (3) inches of hot mix asphalt resurfacing on E. Euclid Avenue (U.S. 6) from York Street to Hubbell Avenue and E. 14th Street (U.S. 69) from E. Ovid Avenue to E. Fleming Avenue, which is in the City of Des Moines. In conjunction with the resurfacing, storm and sewer manhole adjustments and spot replacement of curb and gutter work will be performed. This is an IDOT project; therefore, the IDOT will be the contracting authority responsible for construction of the project. The IDOT cost includes replacement of pedestrian ramps in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act. The City of Des Moines will only be responsible to reimburse the IDOT for the costs of sanitary and storm sewer manhole adjustments and spot replacement of curb and gutter, estimated to be \$21,465. The IDOT will maintain traffic during construction of this project.
