#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: 2016 River Bank Stabilization - Contract 1 - Receiving bids, (12-8-15), and Setting date of hearing, (12-21-15). Construction Estimate - \$125,000.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the stabilization of eroded river banks at two locations: Raccoon River near S.W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Raccoon River near Gray's Lake beach.


Amount: \$125,000 City Engineer's Estimate

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2015-2016 CIP, Page Storm – 10, Levee Maintenance and Improvements, SM134, Being: \$93,850 in Storm Water Utility Funds for S.W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street Repair (Page Storm – 10, Levee Maintenance and Improvements, SM134); \$31,150 G.O. Bonds for Gray's Lake repair (Page Park – 6, Gray's Lake Park Improvements, PK140).

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 River Bank Stabilization - Contract 1, 08-2016-002. The improvement includes river bank stabilization construction including clearing and grubbing, bank grading and shaping, Class D riprap, seeding, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 570-079/087, located at the two (2) following locations: Raccoon River near S.W. 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Raccoon River near Gray's Lake beach, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$125,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
