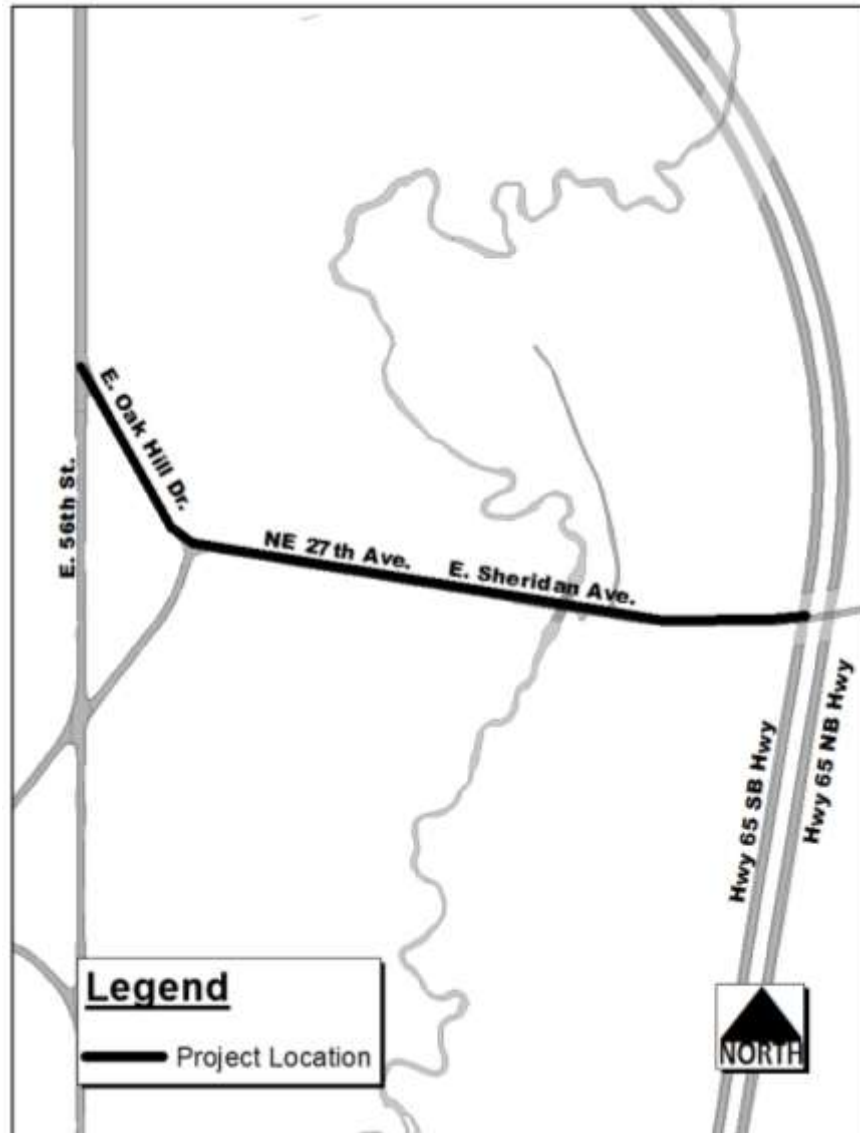

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

Polk County, in coordination with the City of Des Moines has developed a project to resurface E. Oak Hill Drive and NE 27th Avenue, also known as E. Sheridan Avenue, from E. 56th Street to the Highway 65 Overpass. A portion of the roadway is in the boundary between the City Corporate Limits and unincorporated Polk County, requiring improvements to be developed in a coordinated manner. Polk County is the lead agency for this project, and will be performing design and construction management. The proposed agreement has Polk County and the City of Des Moines sharing in the project costs based on the jurisdictional ownership of the roadway.

The project will consist of hot-mix asphalt resurfacing the 2-lane facility. The total project cost is estimated at approximately \$90,620. The project is scheduled to be awarded and construction to begin in 2016. The project is scheduled to be completed by November 2016.
