AGENDA HEADING:

Authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests for the 2016 Storm Sewer Repair Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests for the 2016 Storm Sewer Repair Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the property acquisition process under eminent domain.

This project provides for minor storm sewer and drainage way improvements and emergency repairs for the City storm water system where additional property rights are needed to access the repair locations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: To be determined after final design is completed.

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2016-17 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Storm Water Improvements – 4, City-wide Storm Water Utility Projects, SM057.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- At this time, approximately two (2) temporary construction easements from two (2) property owners will be required for a project located at 50th Street and Douglas Avenue. Relocation assistance will not be required.
- This action authorizes acquisition of the necessary property interests for the above project location and additional locations as additional repair projects are identified in the future.
