## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: 2016 Parking Garage Repair Program - Receiving bids, (3-22-16), and Setting date of hearing, (4-11-16). Construction Estimate - \$407,000.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the repair of structural members to address deterioration that has occurred in the 3<sup>rd</sup> & Court and 4<sup>th</sup> & Grand Parking Garages. This work is necessary to preserve the City's investment in these parking structures and restore their structural integrity.



## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 Parking Garage Repair Program, 04-2016-007. The improvement includes the repair of beam connections, concrete removal, reinforcing steel, concrete patching, structural concrete, shoring, expansion joint repair, storm drains, traffic control, and mobilization; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 571-173/191, located at the 3<sup>rd</sup> & Court and 4<sup>th</sup> & Grand Parking Garages, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$407,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
