AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2016 Skywalk Roof Replacement - Receiving bids, (3-22-16), and Setting date of hearing, (4-11-16). Construction Estimate - \$294,131.75.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the replacement of the last seven (7) skywalk roofs identified for replacement in the 2013 Skywalk Bridge Roof Analysis report. There have been 17 skywalk roofs previously replaced in the past three (3) years.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 Skywalk Roof Replacement, 10-2016-006. The improvement includes the complete removal of the existing roofing materials and installation of an EPDM (ethylene propylene diene terpolymer) roof and associated traffic control; all work in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 571-192/202, located at various skywalk bridges downtown Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$294,131.75. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
