### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests for the 42nd Street Streetscape Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the property acquisition process under eminent domain.

### FISCAL IMPACT:


Amount: \$80,000 total estimated right-of-way acquisition and closing costs.

Funding Source: 2016-17 CIP, Page Street Improvements – 15, Street Improvements Projects, ST258.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

This project provides for streetscape improvements along 42nd Street from I-235 to Crocker Street, including sidewalk improvements, storm sewer, lighting, roadway modifications, and traffic signals. The project also includes a storm sewer from I-235 to Crocker Street, which will provide the opportunity to separate the combined sewer in the area in order to comply with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) decree.

At this time, approximately two (2) partial fee acquisitions (PA), two (2) permanent easements for storm sewer and utilities (PE), and nine (9) temporary construction easements (TE) from nine (9) property owners will be required for this project. Relocation assistance will not be required.
