AGENDA HEADING:

Bituminous Materials & Supply, (Dan Quigley, Plant Manager), for a modification of the annual contract with two (2) additional 1-year renewal options, to furnish emulsified asphalt materials to be used by the Street Maintenance Division, \$200,000.

SYNOPSIS:

The Street Maintenance Division is addressing asphalt stabilized streets which have not been addressed for many years. Previously the City assessed for asphalt stabilizing services. These streets have fallen into disrepair and can no longer be patched. Most stabilized streets will be returned to a gravel/unimproved surface. In high traffic areas, the street will be re-stabilized to reduce maintenance and dust. Restabilizing a street requires the addition of emulsified asphalt not previously planned for in the contracted amount.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$200,000

Funding Source: 2015-16 Operating Budget, S360 PW240402, Street Maintenance Fund, page 238.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Department of Public Works uses emulsified asphalt materials in a variety of preventive maintenance and repair programs including slurry seal coats and asphalt stabilization; additionally, the materials are used to control dust on unpaved streets, stabilize gravel roadways, and to prepare paved streets for hot mix asphalt (HMA) overlay.

On May 4, 2015 Council approved the Bituminous Materials and Supply Company contract for \$300,000. Public Works stabilized 1 mile of E. County Line Road in addition to the slurry seal program. As Public Works addresses streets which were asphalt stabilized nearly 20 years ago, additional emulsified products will be necessary.
