

AGENDA HEADING:

Approving amendment to agreement for professional services for the proposed Rail Port transloading facility.

SYNOPSIS:

On October 20, 2014 by Roll Call No. 14-1668, City Council approved a contract for professional services in an amount not to exceed \$36,340 with McClure Engineering Company (Terry Lutz, President/CEO, 1360 NW 121st Street, Clive, IA 50325) and sub-consultant Engineered Rail Solutions, LLC (David M. Thompson, President, 420 North Front Street, Suite 208, McHenry, IL 60050) for professional advisement on the development of a Request for Proposals (RFP) for identified City-owned land proposed for a Rail Port transloading facility.

This Roll Call requests Council approval for an amendment to the existing contract in the amount of \$15,000. The services provided under the amendment will include assistance with interviewing RFP respondents, making recommendation to City Council on a preferred operator for the Rail Port facility, and assistance with preparation of a \$5 million Fostering Advancement in Shipping and Transportation for the Long Term Achievement of National Efficiencies (FASTLANE) grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation for the development of the project, also included on this Council agenda.
