AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Riverwalk Red Multi-Use Trail Bridge Rehabilitation - Receiving bids, (5-10-16), and Setting date of hearing, (5-23-16). Construction Estimate - \$2,830,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will raise the Riverwalk Red Multi-Use Trail Bridge 4.5-feet in order to reduce the upstream flood profile along the Des Moines River levee system.

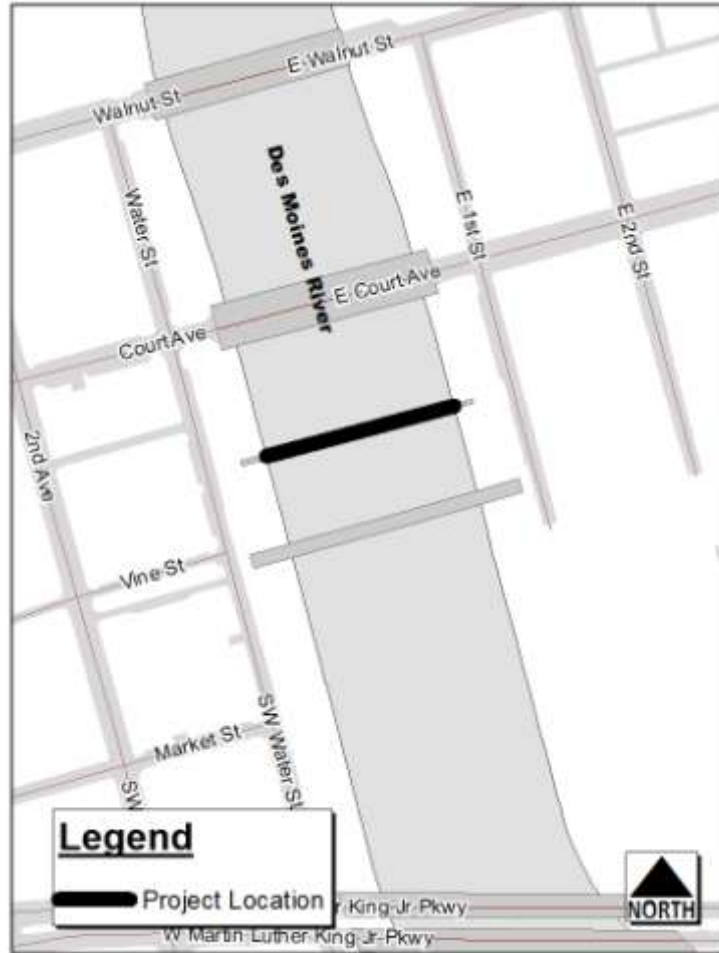

Funding Source: 2016-2017 CIP, Page Storm – 6, Flood Mitigation Improvements, SM087, Being: \$2,710,495 State of Iowa Flood Mitigation Grant; transfer of \$111,105 from BL110, Building - 6, Energy Conservation, G.O. Bonds to be Issued; the remaining \$8,400, SM087, Storm Revenue Bonds to be issued.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer’s estimate for the construction of the Riverwalk Red Multi-Use Trail Bridge Rehabilitation, 12-2014-007. The improvement includes raising the Riverwalk Red Multi-Use Trail Bridge by 4.5-feet, removals, structural concrete, piling, retaining walls, sidewalk, lighting, ADA railings, traffic control, site furnishings, and other incidental items; all work in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 572-003/056, located just south of the Court Avenue Bridge on the Des Moines River, Des Moines, Iowa. Lighting is being upgraded to LED and will be relocated to facilitate maintenance.

The estimated construction cost is \$2,830,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
