AGENDA HEADING:

SYNOPSIS:

The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of City streets by improving deteriorating infrastructure.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 56th Street Rehabilitation from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue, 06-2016-005. The improvement includes rehabilitation of 56th Street from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue with four (f) inches of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). This project will include scarification/pavement removal, full depth patching, furnish and place HMA, pavement markings, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 572-101/110, 56th Street from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$280,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
