AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 56th Street Rehabilitation from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, James Gauger, President, \$223,131.35.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 56th Street Rehabilitation from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for rehabilitation of 56th Street from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue. The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of City streets by improving deteriorating infrastructure.


On April 11, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-0537, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 56th Street Rehabilitation from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 56th Street Rehabilitation from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue, 06-2016-005. The improvement includes rehabilitation of 56th Street from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue with four (4) inches of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). This project will include scarification/pavement removal, full depth patching, furnish and place HMA, pavement markings, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 572-101/110, 56th Street from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Des Moines, IA Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA T K Concrete Inc., Pella, IA

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on April 26, 2016.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, James Gauger, President, P.O. Box 3365, Des Moines, IA, 50316-0365 in the amount of \$223,131.35, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
