## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving Memorandum of Understand (MOU) between the City of Des Moines and the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT), Motor Vehicle Division.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

Approving agreement allowing the City to receive a secure encrypted weekly file transfer from the IDOT containing Iowa vehicle and owner record information in order to issue, verify and process parking related citations, traffic camera violations, and aid in debt collection. The current MOU expires the end of May. The agreement may be signed by the City's IT Director/Chief Information Officer and may be extended for an additional period of two (2) years.
