AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2016 HMA and PCC Partial Depth Repair Program - Receiving bids, (6-28-16), and Setting date of hearing, (7-11-16). Construction Estimate - \$1,232,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will maintain the existing pavement condition of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, S.W. 2nd Street, and S.W. 3rd Street by removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete pavement.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 HMA and PCC Partial Depth Repair Program, 06-2016-006. The improvement includes street rehabilitation by removal and replacement of partial depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) patches, partial depth and full depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patches, pavement markings, truncated domes, bridge approach paving, bridge joint replacement; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 573-223/272, located on Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway between S.W. 2nd Street and S.W. 9th Street, and on S.W. 2nd Street/S.W. 3rd Street between Jackson Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$1,232,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
