AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of contract for annual maintenance and support of the City's mass storage system with Hewlett-Packard per the competitively bid Western States Contracting Alliance (WSCA) pricing agreement.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of agreement with Hewlett-Packard Company, (8000 Foothills Boulevard, MS 5509, Roseville, California, 95747, Meg Whitman, President) per WSCA pricing agreement for support, which is competitively bid. The pricing agreement is effective beginning April 2015 and continuing to April 2017. This annual maintenance and support covers the Hewlett-Packard storage units located in the server room in the Information Technology (IT) Department and at the Des Moines International Airport. Included in this agreement is annual support for backup tape libraries and VMWare (cloud and virtualization software).

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ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- These storage units are critical to the City operations and contain data and files for City applications, user folders, and databases.

- This maintenance combines the several Hewlett Packard maintenance agreements into one (1) interconnected agreement that covers a fiscal year.
- The maintenance agreement provide an essential part of the City's technology infrastructure.
