AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of Agreement for Cooperative Public Service between Polk County, Iowa and the City of Des Moines for the hot mix asphalt repairs to Meredith Drive.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Agreement for Cooperative Public Service between Polk County and the City of Des Moines for the hot mix asphalt repairs of Meredith Drive between Beaver Avenue and Merle Hay Road.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Polk County, in coordination with the City of Des Moines has developed a project to repair Meredith Drive between Beaver Avenue and Merle Hay Road. A portion of the roadway is in the boundary between the City Corporate Limits and unincorporated Polk County, requiring improvements to be developed in a coordinated manner. Polk County is the lead agency for this project, and will be performing design and construction management. The proposed agreement has Polk County and the City of Des Moines sharing in the project costs based on the jurisdictional ownership of the roadway.

The project will consist of full depth patches and sections of 2-inches nominal depth hot mix asphalt overlay to strengthen the existing hot mix asphalt surface. The total project cost is estimated at approximately \$99,100. The project is scheduled to be completed by November 2016.
