### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: Municipal Buildings Reroofing - Contract 2 - Receiving bids, (7-12-16), and Setting date of hearing, (7-25-16). Construction Estimate - \$189,350.

# **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the repair of three municipal building roofs that have deteriorated resulting in leaks throughout the buildings.

Amount: \$189,350 (City Engineer's Estimate)



# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Municipal Buildings Reroofing - Contract 2, 10-2016-008. The improvement includes the repair of the existing roofing materials and installation of a sprayed polyurethane foam roof on three (3) municipal buildings; all work in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 574-008/014, located at Public Works Sign Shop – 216 S.E. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Armory Building – 602 Robert D. Ray Drive, and Glendale Cemetery Abbey – 4909 University Avenue, in Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$189,350. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
