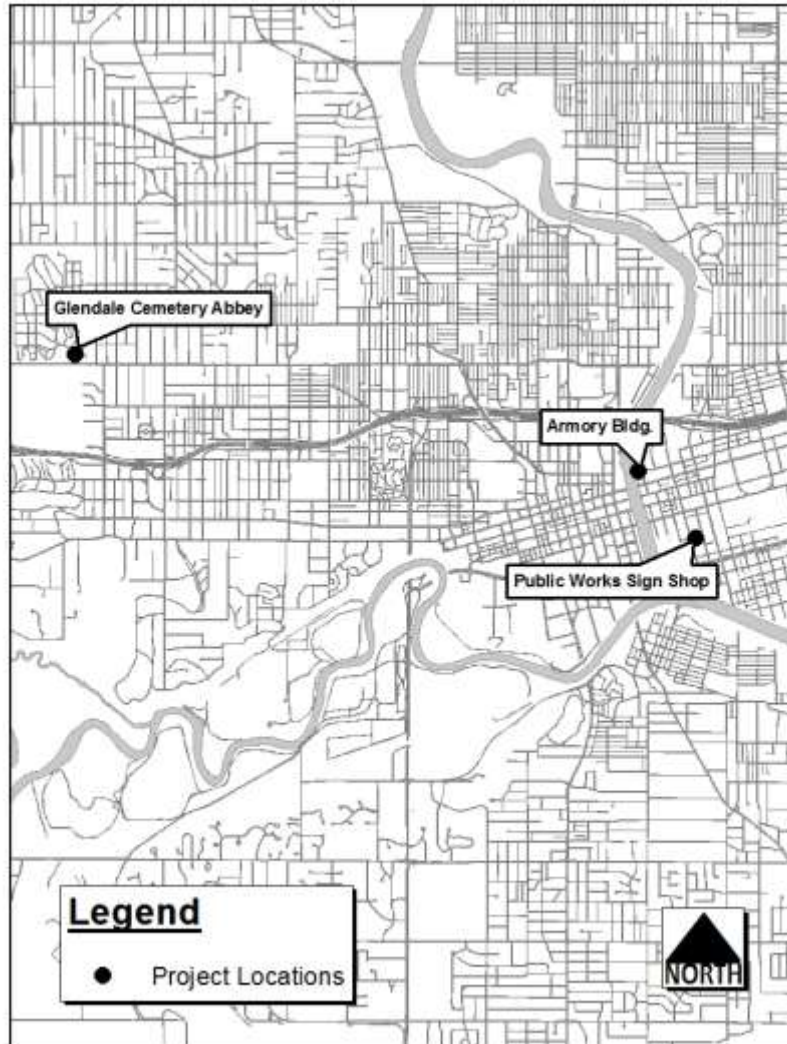

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer’s estimate for the construction of the Municipal Buildings Reroofing - Contract 2, 10-2016-008. The improvement includes the repair of the existing roofing materials and installation of a sprayed polyurethane foam roof on three (3) municipal buildings; all work in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 574-008/014, located at Public Works Sign Shop – 216 S.E. 5th Street, Armory Building – 602 Robert D. Ray Drive, and Glendale Cemetery Abbey – 4909 University Avenue, in Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$189,350. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
