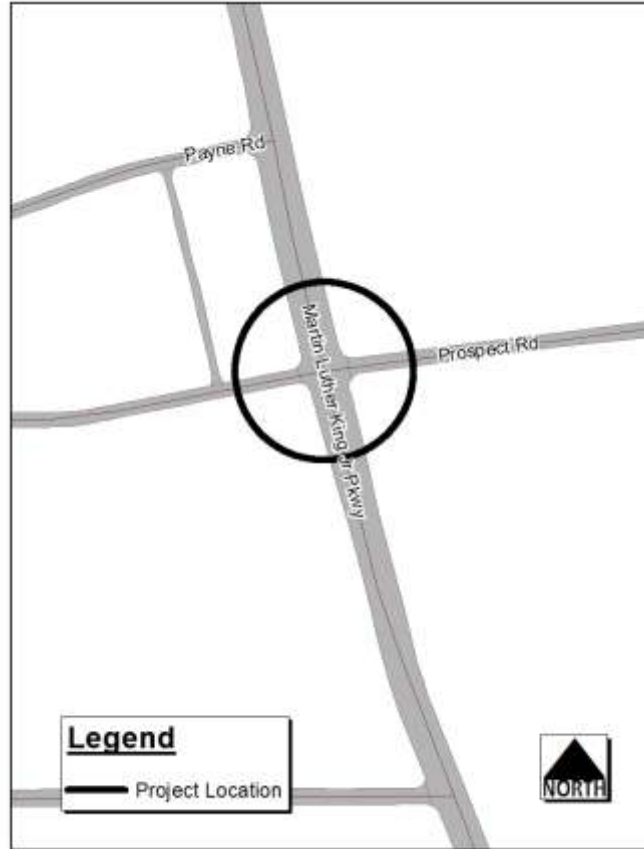

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The MLK Jr. Parkway and Prospect Road Traffic Signal Installation has been identified as a priority project for safety improvements. The project provides for installation of traffic signals at MLK Jr. Parkway and Prospect Road.

This project has received IDOT TSIP funds for a maximum amount of \$120,000. The remaining construction costs, design, inspection, and construction administration are to be funded by the City. The total City cost is estimated to be \$180,000.
