AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2016 HMA and PCC Partial Depth Repair Program. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Glen E. Perkins, President, \$955,056.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2016 HMA and PCC Partial Depth Repair Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will maintain the existing pavement condition of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, S.W. 2nd Street, and S.W. 3rd Street by removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete pavement.

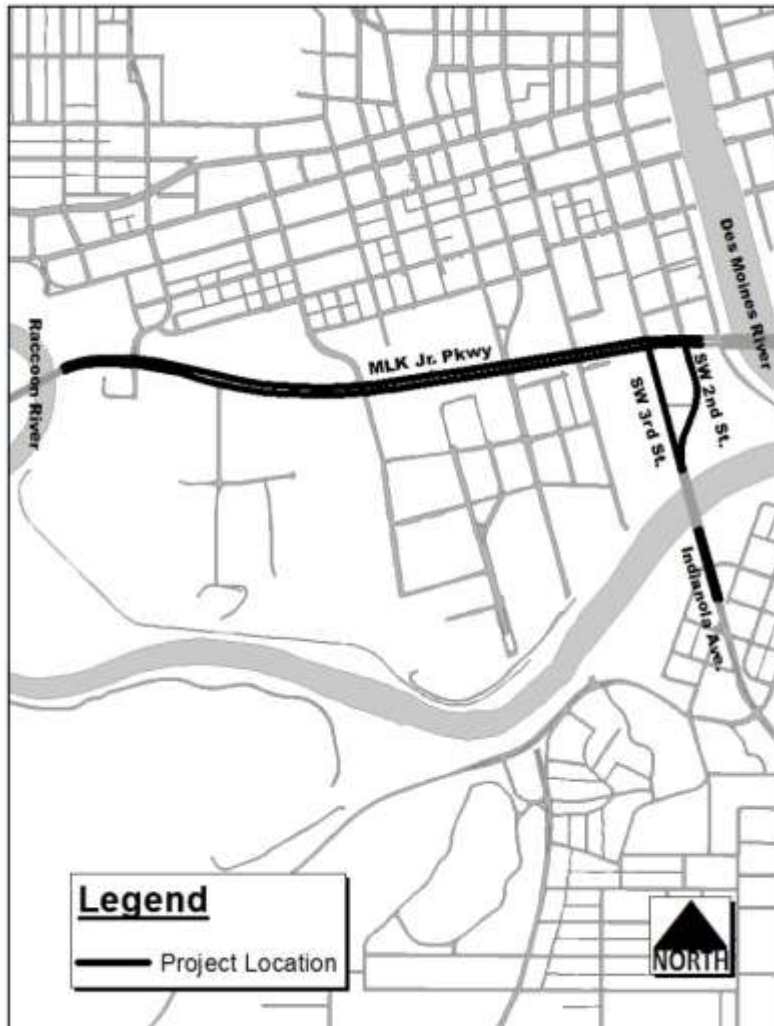
On June 13, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-0927, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 HMA and PCC Partial Depth Repair Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 HMA and PCC Partial Depth Repair Program, 06-2016-006. The improvement includes street rehabilitation by removal and replacement of partial depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) patches, partial depth and full depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patches, pavement markings, truncated domes, bridge approach paving, bridge joint replacement; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 573-223/272, located on Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway between S.W. 2nd Street and S.W. 9th Street, and on S.W. 2nd Street/S.W. 3rd Street between Jackson Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa.
