AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2016-2017 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Jeffrey A. Chapman, General Manager, \$325,479.25.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2016-2017 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and HMA overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the streets.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$325,479.25 Construction Contract (\$276,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2016-2017 CIP, Page Street - 4, Asphaltic Paving Restoration Program, ST003, Being: \$230,377.75 in G.O. Bonds and \$26,781.50 in TIF backed G.O. Bonds from ST003, and \$68,320.00 in G.O. Bonds from ST205, Neighborhood Infrastructure Rehabilitation Program, Page Street - 24.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On June 27, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-1021, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016-2017 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016-2017 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 06-2016-009. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inches average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

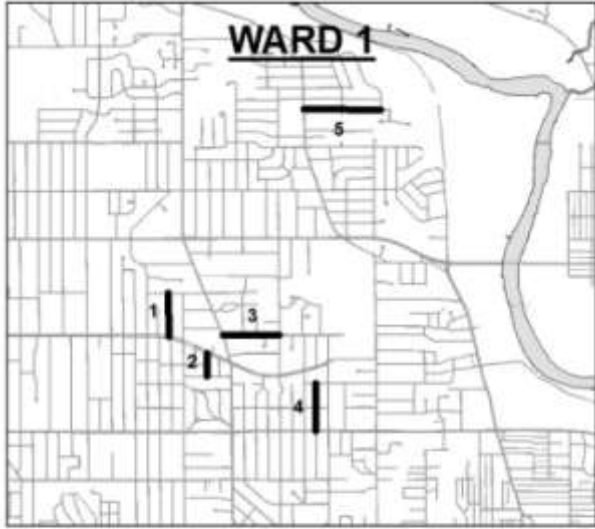

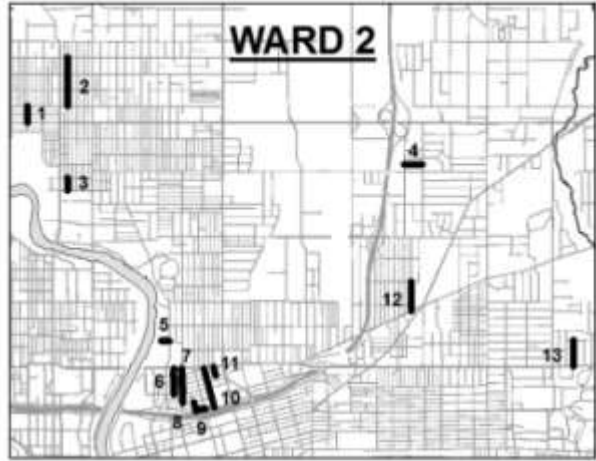
