### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with Foth Infrastructure and Environment, LLC, for additional professional services for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements, for an additional amount not to exceed \$997,600.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Foth Infrastructure and Environment, LLC, Patrick Kueter, Principal-in-Charge, 8191 Birchwood Court, Suite L, Johnston, Iowa, 50131, for an additional amount not to exceed \$997,600, based on hourly rates, to provide additional design phase services for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On July 13, 2015 by Roll Call 15-1123, the City Council approved a Professional Services Agreement with Foth Infrastructure and Environment, LLC for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements.

On April 11, 2016 by Roll Call 16-0552, the City Council approved the conceptual plan for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor.

Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with Foth Infrastructure and Environment, LLC provides for the design of the project in accordance with the approved conceptual plan. Construction is planned to begin in 2019.
