AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Police Station North and South Elevator Replacement. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Eletech, Inc., Mike Cimino, President, \$257,233.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Police Station North and South Elevator Replacement and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project will replace one (1) hydraulic passenger elevator installed in 1981 and one (1) geared passenger elevator installed in 1975.


On June 27, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-1019, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Police Station North and South Elevator Replacement. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Police Station North and South Elevator Replacement, 10-2016-003. The improvement includes modernizing one (1) Montgomery hydraulic passenger elevator and one (1) Otis geared passenger elevator at the Des Moines Police Station. The hydraulic elevator includes a new microprocessor controller, new pumping unit, new motor, new oil, battery lowering unit, new door operator, door restrictors, new cab and fixtures. The new geared elevator includes a new microprocessor controller, new rope brake, new door operator, door restrictors, new cab and new vandal resistant fixtures, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, located at 25 East 1st Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Eletech, Inc., Omaha, NE Otis Elevator Company, Urbandale, IA Schumacher Elevator Company, Denver, IA

The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the Shijiazhuang Room, 2nd Floor, City Administration Building, 400 E. Court Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on July 12, 2016.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Eletech, Inc., Mike Cimino, President, 8810 Blondo Street, Omaha, NE, 68134 in the amount of \$257,233, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
