ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:


The following changes are necessary to update the Municipal Code following the vacation of E 42nd Street between Williams Street and E 42nd Street.

Sec. 114-2924. East Forty-second Street—East Washington Avenue Williams Street to East Aurora Avenue.

East Forty-second Street, on the west side, from East Washington Avenue Williams Street to Easton Boulevard, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3756. East Washington Avenue—Dead end west of Pennsylvania Avenue to East Forty-second Street the dead end east of East Thirty-third Street.

East Washington Avenue, on the south side, from Williams Street to East Forty-second Street, no parking any time.
