AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 7th & Center Park and Ride Facility Rehabilitation. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Kenwood Company, John Naughter, President/CEO, \$214,450.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 7th & Center Park and Ride Facility Rehabilitation and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the repair of the concrete parking surface and corroded metal members to address deterioration that has occurred in the 7th & Center Street Parking Garage. This work is necessary to preserve the City's investment in this parking structure.

Amount: \$214,450 Construction Contract (\$255,000 City Engineer's Estimate)


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On July 25, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-1180, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 7th & Center Park and Ride Facility Rehabilitation. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 7th & Center Park and Ride Facility Rehabilitation, 04-2016-016. The improvement includes cleaning and sealing concrete parking surface, pavement markings, cleaning and painting corroded metal, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk replacement, and new handicapped parking stall signs; all in accordance with the contract documents, located at the 7th & Center Street Parking Garage, Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Kenwood Company, St. Paul, MN Bi-State Masonry, Inc., Rock Island, IL Fisher Building Services, Inc., Carter Lake, IA - Bid not read – Proposal pages 2 and 3 missing The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the Shijiazhuang Room, 2nd Floor, City Administration Building, 400 E. Court Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on August 9, 2016.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Kenwood Company, John Naughter, President/CEO, 1955 West Kenwood Drive, St. Paul, MN, 55117 in the amount of \$214,450.00, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
