AGENDA HEADING:

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the construction of a plaza in Ewing Park. 

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Ewing Park Lilac Plaza, 11-2015-010. The improvement includes placement of fill, rock subbase, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) paving, erosion control, seeding, restoration and other incidental items; all work in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 576-063/090, in Ewing Park, Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$37,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
