AGENDA HEADING:

Approving agreement with MidAmerican Energy Company to install LED street lights for Indianola Avenue Phase 4, not to exceed \$66,992.93.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of agreement between the City of Des Moines and MidAmerican Energy Company, Derek Degen, Customer Technician, 200 S.E. 3rd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50309, to install LED street lights for Indianola Avenue Phase 4.

Amount: \$66,992.93

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The current street lights along Indianola Avenue Phase 4 from E. Porter Avenue to Army Post Road are to be replaced by new LED street lighting similar to Phases 1-3 of Indianola Avenue. The street lights will be installed with a combination over-head conductor to the existing power poles and underground conductor to the new direct embedded galvanized steel poles. MidAmerican Energy prepared plans for the street lighting based on street lighting analysis provided by the City. The poles and fixtures will be owned and maintained by MidAmerican Energy.
