

Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Principal Park Cub Club Parking Lot Improvement includes construction of sidewalks, parking lot Improvements, 11-2016-009. The improvement includes construction of sidewalks, parking lot modifications with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and Portland Cement Concrete (PCC), pavement markings, parking signage, site restoration, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 574-140/151, at Principal Park, 1 Line Drive, Des Moines, Iowa.
