#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of the purchase of two (2) Hewlett-Packard (HP) 3PAR 8400 storage arrays from OneNeck IT Solutions per State of Iowa contract pricing agreement for storage of in-car and body camera data and videos.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the purchase of two (2) HP 3PAR 8400 servers from OneNeck IT Solutions (11191 Aurora Avenue, Urbandale, IA 50323) per the State of Iowa pricing agreement (HPE Contract #16054). The HP 3PAR storage systems will be used to store data and videos for the in-car and body camera solution. One (1) system will be located in the Armory building and the additional system will be located at a separate City facility. These systems will operate in a primary and backup roll, where each system will mirror the other.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The City is replacing the in-car camera system in 100 police vehicles and adding 300 body worn cameras. This data will be stored on the City network. The HP 3PAR will provide high availability and resiliency with automated disaster recovery configuration. One (1) of the HP 3PAR systems will remain at the Armory, while the other will be located off-site at an alternate City location for business continuity in case of the loss of the City's current data center. The additional 3PAR will serve as a backup for the primary system.
