## AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Leetown Creekway Channel Improvements. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Elder Corporation, Jared R. Elder II, President, \$1,699,000.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Leetown Creekway Channel Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will stabilize the Leetown Creekway channel from Union Pacific Railroad to Four Mile Creek. The stabilization of the banks will provide for better flow capacity of the channel and mitigate erosion issues in the channel, which will improve water quality discharged into the Des Moines River.


On August 22, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-1379, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Leetown Creekway Channel Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Leetown Creekway Channel Improvements, 08-2014-003. The improvement includes clearing & grubbing, excavation, placement of rip rap protection, grading of channel banks, storm sewer installation, erosion control, seeding, restoration and other incidental items; all work in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 574-174/214, along Leetown Creekway in Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
