AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Cooperative Agreement with Polk County Conservation Board to provide cooperative access to the Hartford Avenue Clean Fill Site.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Cooperative Agreement with Polk County Conservation Board to provide cooperative access to the City’s clean fill landfill on Hartford Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City operates a clean fill landfill site on property adjacent to the James W. Cownie Baseball complex on Hartford Avenue. It is used to dispose of soil, rubble concrete pavements, and detritus from excavations performed by Public Works Department crews.
- The Polk County Conservation Board will be building several bridges in the construction of the trail around Easter Lake and is in need of large quantities of fill material for bridge abutments.
- The Hartford landfill site is the closest source of borrow material for the earthwork.
- Permitting removal of clean fill material from the landfill at no cost to the City extends the useful life of the landfill and is a great benefit to the City.
