AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2016 Skywalk Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) Replacement - Receiving bids, (11-8-16), and Setting date of hearing, (11-21-16). Construction Estimate - \$266,900.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project includes the replacement of four (4) Skywalk HVAC units including necessary structural improvements and electrical upgrades. This project will replace four (4) Skywalk HVAC units identified for replacement in the 2016 Des Moines Skywalk Bridge HVAC Analysis report. These are the first four (4) of 16 HVAC units identified as needing replaced in the next five (5) years.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 Skywalk HVAC Replacement, 04-2017-003. The project includes removal and replacement of four (4) Skywalk HVAC units, including necessary structural improvements, electrical upgrades, roofing replacements, and traffic control; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 576-152/168, located at Skywalk bridges 1C-2C, 4A-4E, 5D-5E, 7D-8D in downtown Des Moines, Iowa.

The estimated construction cost is \$266,900. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
