David Jahn (R-0), Municipal Arborist, to Boston, MA from November 29 – December 3, 2016 (\$2,985) to attend the American Society of Consulting Arborists annual conference. This conference offers a deeper and more extensive array of topics from other arborist educational programs.

Skip Moore (R-0), Council Member, to Pittsburgh, PA from November 16 – November 19, 2016 (\$2,367) to attend the National League of Cities City Summit conference. This conference offers exceptional educational and networking opportunities to increase the effectiveness of local leaders.

The original budget for travel and training in Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 is \$524,665. The amount expended for travel and training in FY 2017, as of October 18, 2016, is \$124,108.04.
