AGENDA HEADING:

Declaration of intent regarding proposed rail port transload facility.

SYNOPSIS:

Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway Company (BNSF) has previously operated rail service in the E. Elm Street right-of-way in the Market District. That section of line is no longer active and the former rail bridge over the Des Moines River has been converted to a pedestrian bridge with the construction of the Principal Riverwalk.

The City of Des Moines has received notice from BNSF that it will not apply to the Surface Transportation Board for abandonment of its rail line within the City-owned E. Elm Street right-of-way extending west from SE 9th Street at this time, because BNSF wants to preserve the ability to reactivate the rail line within the E. Elm Street right-of-way for use in serving the proposed rail port transload facility. This declaration provides clarity that the City has no intent to give final approval to the proposed rail port transload if it will result in rail traffic on E. Elm Street west of SE 9th Street.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

The reactivation of the rail line within the E. Elm Street right-of-way west of SE 9th Street is incompatible with:

- The City's Comprehensive Plan;
- The Downtown Plan titled "What's Next, Downtown?";
- The Market District of East Village Urban Design Study;
- The planned improvements to E. Elm Street adjoining the new headquarters office building for PDM Precast, Inc., and GPS Impact, now under construction at 220 SE 6th Street along the 500 block of E. Elm Street; and,
- The rededication and improvement of E. Elm Street between SE 6th and SE 7th Streets to serve a proposed new housing project north of the 600 block of E. Elm Street.
