**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for the resurfacing of Hickman Road (U.S. 6) in the cities of Clive, Urbandale, Windsor Heights, and Des Moines from I/35/80 east to the east junction of Merle Hay Road (Iowa 28).

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of the IDOT Agreement No. 2017-6-063 for resurfacing Hickman Road (US 6) in the cities of Clive, Urbandale, Windsor Heights, and Des Moines, from I-35/80 east to the east junction of Merle Hay Road (Iowa 28). The IDOT will construct the Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) resurfacing utilizing IDOT funds. The City will only be responsible to reimburse the IDOT for the costs of the curb ramp construction at the intersection of 50<sup>th</sup> Street within the City of Des Moines estimated to be \$9,400.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$9,400

Funding Source: 2017-2018 CIP, Page Street - 28, Rehabilitation and Preservation of Major Roadways, ST222, G.O. Bonds

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

The IDOT has determined that it is necessary to resurface Hickman Road (US 6) with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) in the cities of Clive, Urbandale, Windsor Heights, and Des Moines from I/35/80 east to the east junction of Merle Hay Road (Iowa 28). This is an IDOT project; therefore, the IDOT will be the contracting authority responsible for construction of the project. The City of Des Moines will only be responsible to reimburse the IDOT for the costs of the curb ramp construction at the intersection of Hickman Road (U.S. 6) and 60<sup>th</sup> Street within the City of Des Moines, estimated to be \$9,400. The IDOT will maintain traffic during construction of this project.
