AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2016 Skywalk HVAC Replacement: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Stroh Corporation, Bob Blaskovich, Vice President, \$368,209.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2016 Skywalk HVAC Replacement and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project includes the replacement of four (4) Skywalk HVAC units including necessary structural improvements and electrical upgrades. This project will replace four (4) Skywalk HVAC units identified as in need of replacement from the 2016 Des Moines Skywalk Bridge HVAC Analysis report. These are first four (4) of 16 HVAC units identified as needing replaced in the next five (5) years.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

On October 24, 2016, under Roll Call No. 16-1801, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 Skywalk HVAC Replacement. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2016 Skywalk HVAC Replacement, 04-2017-003. The project includes removal and replacement of four (4) Skywalk HVAC units, including necessary structural improvements, electrical upgrades, roofing replacements, and traffic control; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 576-152/168, located at Skywalk bridges 1C-2C, 4A-4E, 5D-5E, 7D-8D in downtown Des Moines, Iowa.

Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

Stroh Corporation, Des Moines, IA Brocon Services LLC, Johnston, IA Air Con Mechanical, Corp., Des Moines, IA The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the Shijiazhuang Room, 2nd Floor, City Administration Building, 400 E. Court Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on November 8, 2016. Currently, the steel prices are increasing. These higher steel prices resulted in higher than expected costs for the metal screen panels and galvanized structural members, which also resulted in higher bids.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Stroh Corporation, Bob Blaskovich, Vice President, 5000 Park Avenue, Des Moines, IA, 50321 in the amount of \$368,209, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
