AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of an increase in purchasing authority from \$110,000 to \$165,600 for the acquisition of new/replacement Personal Protective Equipment (PPE); fire coats and fire pants.

SYNOPSIS:

Approving an increase in purchasing authority from \$110,000 to \$165,600, per Council Communication 15-012, for the acquisition of PPE comprised of fire coats and pants. With the successful award of the SAFER grant, 13 new firefighter positions will require protective clothing. Outfitting incumbent and new firefighter positions, for their training academy, requires the additional funding.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Increase of \$55,600, from \$110,000 to \$165,600.

Funding Source: FY2017, Operating Budget Organization FD104113, Account 532260 – Safety and Protective Equipment and Clothing. Page 105.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Increasing the purchasing authority from \$110,000 to \$165,600, per Council Communication 15-012, for the acquisition of PPE comprised of fire coats and pants is based on the following:

- Coat and Pant combination anticipation Feb 2017: \$2,300 per set
 - Existing replacement schedule (annual): 42 sets
 - Anticipated January 2017 training academy: 20 sets
 - Other replacements: 10 sets
