AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of the Fire Department and Physio-Control, LLC four (4) year service agreement for LifePak 15 heart monitors, defibrillators, and Lund University Cardiopulmonary Assist System (LUCAS) devices and three (3) year service agreement for LifePak 12 heart monitors.

SYNOPSIS:

The Fire Department recommends approval to purchase a technical service support agreement from Physio-Control, PO Box 97023, 11811 Willows Road N.E., Redmond, WA 98073. This agreement will provide annual service maintenance for the Fire Department's 14 LifePak 15 heart monitors, 19 LifePak 1000 automatic external defibrillators, nine (9) LUCAS heart compression devices, and four (4) LifePak 12 heart monitors which are reaching their end of life and will be in need of replacement. This is why there is only a three (3) year maintenance agreement for them.

Amount: \$153,988.80 (to be paid in four (4) annual installments of \$38,497.20)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Periodic maintenance of these devices by a certified Physio Control technician provides longer service life and assures this medical equipment will deliver optimal performance when used by Fire Department EMS personnel when responding to medical emergencies. The service agreement has an added benefit of providing maximum trade-in value at the end of a device's service life.
