AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc., for professional services for North of Grand Traffic Study, not to exceed \$38,700.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Professional Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc., Steve Heyer, PE, President/CEO, 5525 Merle Hay Road, Suite 200, Johnston, IA 50131, for a total cost not to exceed \$38,700, based on hourly rates, to provide professional services to study the volume, speed, and crash history of traffic at several key locations throughout the North of Grand neighborhood as identified by the neighborhood association and recommend traffic control or traffic calming improvements.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- In a letter dated November 25, 2015, from the President of the North of Grand Neighborhood
 Association to the Des Moines Mayor and City Council, the neighborhood requested the City to
 perform a study of traffic patterns through residential streets in the North of Grand
 Neighborhood to address cut-through traffic, excessive speeding, and identify appropriate
 traffic calming elements.
- Staff attended the May 2016 North of Grand Neighborhood Association meeting to discuss the request further and gather additional details on specific concerns throughout the neighborhood. Those specific concerns were used to develop the scope of the North of Grand Traffic Study.
- HR Green, Inc., was one (1) of the firms selected in September 2015 to perform 2016-2017 On-Call Traffic Engineering Services for the City. Staff has negotiated a Professional Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc., for a total cost not to exceed \$38,700, based on hourly rates, to provide North of Grand Traffic Study services.
