AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 42nd Street Streetscape from I-235 to Crocker Street - Receiving bids, (2-21-17), and Setting date of hearing, (3-6-17). Construction Estimate - \$1,950,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the construction of streetscape enhancements on 42nd Street from I-235 to Crocker Street and on Chamberlain Drive west of 42nd Street. The intersection of 42nd Street and Crocker Street will be enhanced to improve vehicular and pedestrian safety and new traffic signals will be installed. The project also includes the construction of storm sewer along 42nd Street to separate existing combined sewers and improve the overall drainage in the area.


Amount: \$1,950,000 (City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2016-2017 CIP, Page Street - 15, 42nd Street Streetscape, ST258, being: \$480,000 (maximum) in Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds being 80% eligible construction costs under TAP-T-1945(832)--8V-77; \$500,000 (maximum) in Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Traffic Safety Funds under CS-TSF-1945(829)--85-77; \$318,669.17 in Storm Water Utility Funds, SM057; \$470,000 in private donations from Roosevelt Cultural District; \$10,000 in Des Moines Water Works for water main relocation; and the remaining \$171,330.83 in G.O. Bonds, ST258.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 42nd Street Streetscape from I-235 to Crocker Street, 04-2016-010. The improvement includes construction of sidewalks, driveways, site furnishings, plantings, and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) paving, together with the necessary removals, earthwork, clearing and grubbing, erosion control, subdrains, storm sewers, traffic control, traffic signals, and street lighting; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 577-132/218, on 42nd Street from I-235 to Crocker Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

• The estimated construction cost is \$1,950,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
