AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Park Avenue Elementary Pedestrian Bridge Removal and Site Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as T K Concrete Inc., Tony J. SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Park Avenue Elementary Pedestrian Bridge Removal and Site Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project includes the removal of a pedestrian bridge over S.W. 9th Street near Park Avenue, the removal of the southbound right-turn lane on S.W. 9th Street, and construction of parking insets along Park Avenue and S.W. 7th Street, adjacent to Park Avenue Elementary School.


- On January 23, 2017, under Roll Call No. 17-0085, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Park Avenue Elementary Pedestrian Bridge Removal and Site Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Park Avenue Elementary Pedestrian Bridge Removal and Site Improvements, 04-2017-002.
- The improvement includes the removal of a pedestrian bridge over S.W. 9th Street near Park Avenue and the southbound right-turn lane on S.W. 9th Street, construction of Portland Concrete Cement (PCC) on-street parking insets, curb and gutter, sidewalks and curb ramps, segmental block retaining walls, fencing, and concrete steps, together with the necessary removals, earthwork, clearing and grubbing, erosion control, storm sewers, traffic control and

incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 578-063/117, along S.W. 9th Street, Park Avenue, and S.W. 7th Street near Park Avenue Elementary School, Des Moines, Iowa.
