AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on E. 2nd Street Reconstruction from E. Locust Street to E. Grand Avenue: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as MPS Engineers, P.C. dba Kingston Services, P.C., Dan Hutton, President, \$659,983.50.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the E. 2nd Street Reconstruction from E. Locust Street to E. Grand Avenue and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project reconstructs East 2nd Street between East Grand Avenue and East Locust Street to add turn lanes to accommodate the East 2nd Street Parking Garage and improve drainage. The project has been coordinated with the development at 219 East Grand Avenue and the Metro Waste Authority.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$659,983.50 Construction Contract (\$565,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2017-2018 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street – 13, East Village Street Improvements, ST262, Being: \$567,271.50 in Tax Increment Bonds, ST262; and the remaining \$92,712 from Des Moines Water Works.


On February 20, 2017, under Roll Call No. 17-0251, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the E. 2nd Street Reconstruction from E. Locust Street to E. Grand Avenue. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the E. 2nd Street Reconstruction from E. Locust Street to E. Grand Avenue, 06-2017-003. The improvement includes pavement removal, 8-inch Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, storm sewer, water main, earthwork, PCC sidewalks, pavement markings, lighting, traffic control, erosion protection, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) patches, tree planting, landscaping, construction survey; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 578-198/236, at East 2nd Street between East Grand Avenue and East Locust Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by MPS Engineers, P.C. dba Kingston Services, P.C., Dan Hutton, President, 1444 Illinois Street, Des Moines, IA, 50314 in the amount of \$659,983.50, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
