**AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on 2017 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Residential Paving Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$726,608.40.

**SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2017 HMA Residential Paving Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the paving of residential streets utilizing surface scarification and HMA to pave the surface in order to extend the useful service life of the streets. This project includes constructing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalk curb ramps within the project areas. The 45th Street location will be reconstructed with new curb and gutter and full depth HMA.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$726,608.40 Construction Contract (\$736,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2017-18 CIP, Page Street – 30, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Being: \$170,334.40 in G.O. Bonds to be issued, ST065, and the remaining \$556,274 in Road Use Tax Funds, ST260.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- On March 6, 2017, under Roll Call No. 17-0346, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2017 HMA Residential Paving Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2017 HMA Residential Paving Program, 06-2017-009. The improvement includes furnishing all labor, materials and equipment necessary to construct a 3-inch average thickness pavement scarification and a HMA surfacing overlay on existing street surface, traffic control, together with other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract plans and documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

S.W. 1st Street from Olinda Avenue to Davis Avenue  
E. 13th Street from Hull Avenue to E. Ovid Avenue  
38th Street from Douglas Avenue to Madison Avenue  
50th Street at Douglas Avenue  
59th Street from Sheridan Avenue to New York Avenue  
62nd Street from New York Avenue to Urbandale Avenue  
Allison Avenue from dead end east of 27th Street to dead end west of 27th Street  
College Avenue from Merle Hay Road to 62nd Street  
Holcomb Avenue from 30th Street to 33rd Street  
New York Avenue from 61st Street to 62nd Street  
Villa Vista Drive from Hull Avenue to Richmond Avenue

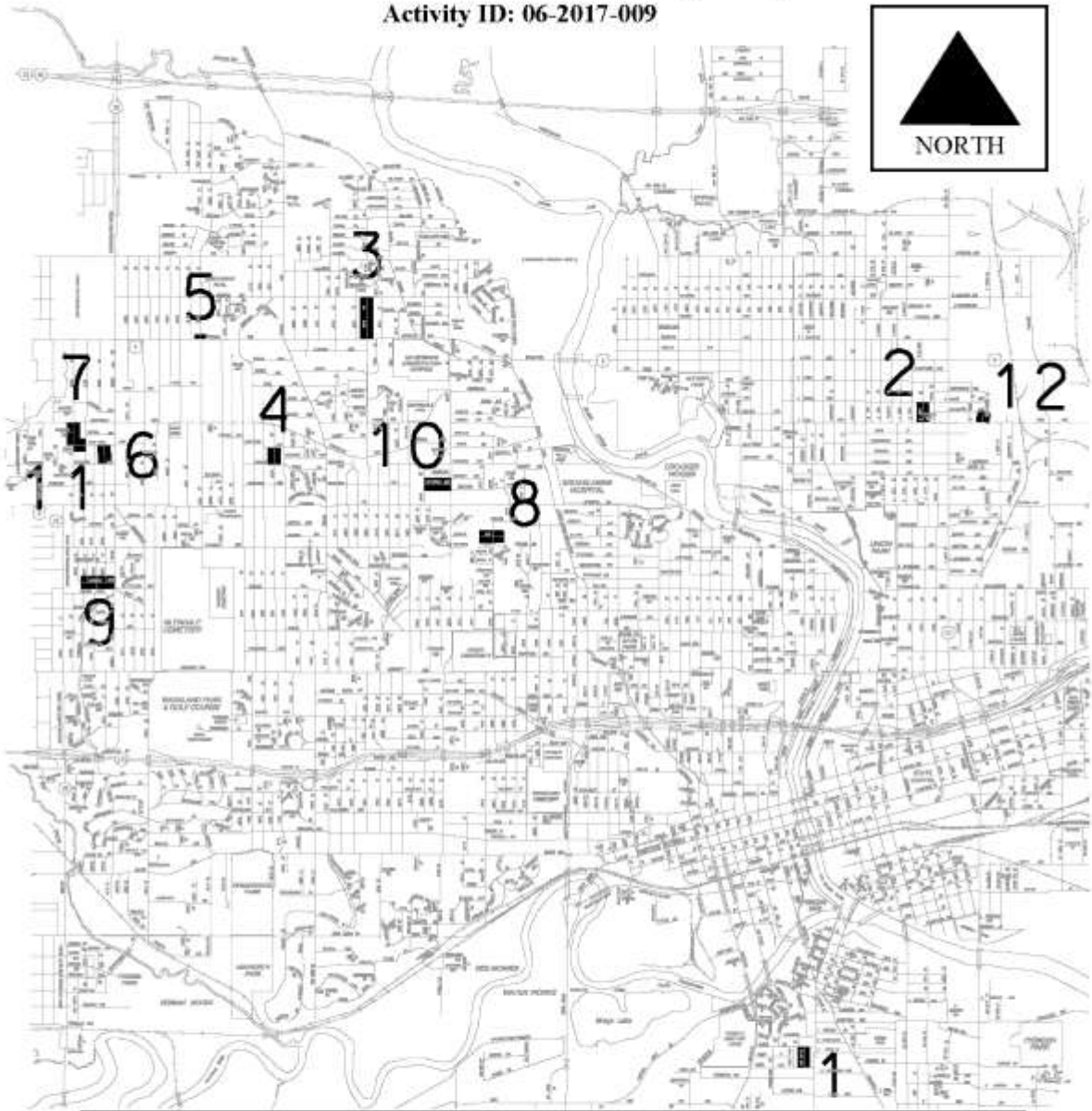

The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 for \$726,608.40, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
