AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc. for design services on the S.E. 1st & Van Buren Street/S.E. 4th Street & Van Buren Street Storm Water Pump Station, not to exceed \$412,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc., James Rasmussen, Water President, 5525 Merle Hay Road, Suite 200, Johnston, Iowa, 50131, for total cost not to exceed \$412,000, based on hourly rates, to provide design services on the S.E. 1st & Van Buren Street/S.E. 4th Street & Van Buren Street Storm Water Pump Station.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On August 22, 2016, by Roll Call No. 16-1385, HR Green, Inc. was hired to provide Conceptual Design Services for the S.E. 1st & Van Buren Street/S.E. 4th Street & Van Buren Street Storm Water Pump Station, including:
 - ➤ Hydrologic and hydraulic analysis to determine pump station capacity and related storm sewer improvements.
 - ➤ Conceptual design and preliminary cost estimates including pump station configuration, layout, and piping plan and storm sewer alignments.
 - Preparation of architectural conceptual design for initial submittal and presentation to the Urban Design Review Board.

- Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with HR Green, Inc. provides for Final Design Services for the S.E. 1st & Van Buren Street/S.E. 4th Street & Van Buren Street Storm Water Pump Station, including:
 - Geotechnical engineering.
 - ➤ Preparation of construction plans, detail drawings, and specifications including civil, structural, architectural, mechanical, and electrical.
 - Preparation of architectural design for final submittal and presentation to the Urban Design Review Board.
 - ➤ Environmental services including completing material handling plans for identified contamination at the site, wetland delineation, habitat assessment, and completion of a Phase 1 Archaeological Study.
 - ➤ Preparation of necessary permit applications and securing approval from relevant permitting agencies including US Army Corps of Engineers, Iowa Department of Natural Resources, and City of Des Moines.
- The preliminary estimated construction cost for the new pump station and storm sewer is approximately \$9.6 million.
- Staff recommends approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 for professional services with HR Green, Inc.
