

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City of Pleasant Hill, in coordination with the City of Des Moines has developed a project to resurface S.E. 43rd Street from Carlisle Road to Vandalia Road. A portion of the roadway is in the boundary between the City of Des Moines Corporate Limits and Pleasant Hill Corporate Limits, requiring improvements to be developed in a coordinated manner. The City of Pleasant Hill is the lead agency for this project and will be performing design and construction management. The proposed agreement requires the City of Pleasant Hill and the City of Des Moines share in the project costs based on the jurisdictional ownership of the roadway.
- The project will consist of milling, patching, and a hot-mix asphalt overlay to strengthen the existing hot-mix asphalt pavement. The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2017.
