
# SYNOPSIS:

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

• As part of the City's Neighborhood Recognition Policy, Recognized Neighborhoods are required to submit a variety of information once a year to maintain their recognized status. The neighborhood survey was mailed March 10, 2017 to all neighborhoods and due June 1, 2017. In response to the survey, ACCENT Neighborhood indicated that while their membership has doubled in the last year, they were unable to get members to serve on the Neighborhood Association Board. As a result, the Neighborhood is unable to meet the requirements of the City's Neighborhood Recognition Policy and has requested City Staff to remove the Neighborhood Association from the list of Recognized Neighborhood Associations. The ACCENT Neighborhood has an estimated population of 1,957 (source: 2015 American Community Survey).
