AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement with WSP USA, Inc. for professional services for the Women of Achievement Pedestrian Bridge Inspection, not to exceed \$34,294.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Professional Services Agreement with WSP USA, Inc., Richard F. O'Brien, Vice President/Area Manager, 9 Trolley Crossing Road, Charlton, MA 01507, for a total cost not to exceed \$34,294, based on hourly rates, to provide professional services for Women of Achievement Pedestrian Bridge Inspection.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Construction of the Iowa Women of Achievement Bridge began in August 2007 and was completed and opened in June 2010.
- On November 7, 2016, by Roll Call Number No. 16-1952, City Council approved plans, specifications, form of contract documents, Engineer's Estimate and designated the lowest responsible bidder as Iowa State Contractors, Inc. for \$244,000 to replace the deck surface. This work is currently underway.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued, posted on the City's website, and printed in the newspaper to provide bridge inspection services for the Women of Achievement Bridge.
- A selection committee of Facilities and Engineering staff reviewed and rated the seven (7) proposals received in response to the RFP. WSP USA, Inc. was selected based on their qualifications and the selection criteria in the RFP.

- Staff negotiated a Professional Services Agreement for a total cost not to exceed \$34,294, based on hourly rates, to provide bridge inspection services for the Women of Achievement Bridge in 2017. The bridge inspection services include:
 - O Performing a field inspection of the bridge elements (deck, arch and deck steel box members, arch cables, concrete abutments).
 - Preparing and providing a report summarizing the condition of the bridge and recommended repairs and maintenance with cost estimates.
