AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement with Walter P. Moore and Associates, Inc. for 2018 Parking Garage Structural Repair Design, not to exceed \$97,140.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Professional Services Agreement with Walter P. Moore and Associates, Inc., Dilip Choudhuri, President and CEO, 1301 McKinney, Suite 1100, Houston, Texas, 77010, for a total cost not to exceed \$97,140, based on hourly rates, to provide professional services for 2018 Parking Garage Structural Repair Design.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- In December 2016, the Engineering Department completed a review of all structural issues of all seven (7) City of Des Moines parking garages.
- Five (5) of the garages (3rd & Court, 4th & Grand, 7th & Center, 8th & Mulberry, and 9th & Locust) have issues that require further design and construction engineering. The items noted in the 2016 Structural Parking Facility Condition Study are high priority repairs.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) for the 2018 Parking Garage Structural Repair Design was
 issued, posted on the City's website, and printed in the newspaper. A selection committee of
 Engineering staff reviewed and rated the three (3) proposals received in response to the RFP.
 Walter P. Moore and Associates, Inc. was selected based on the selection criteria in the RFP
 and their direct knowledge of all the structural issues associated with parking garage system.

- City staff has negotiated a Professional Services Agreement with Walter P. Moore and Associates, Inc. for professional services for a total cost not to exceed \$97,140, based on hourly rates. Design services include detail miscellaneous concrete and structural steel repairs identified in the December 2016 Facility Condition Study for the 8th & Mulberry, 9th & Locust, and the 3rd & Court parking garages for FY2018. The construction budget for repairs is \$600,000 for FY2018.
- The design is scheduled to be completed this fall. Additional designs will be required for FY2019 repairs, which include the 4th & Grand and 7th & Center parking garages. Saul Engineering, a subconsultant to Walter P. Moore and Associates, Inc., will also provide emergency response / on-call services for structural review and assessment of City facilities as requested by the City.
