# AGENDA HEADING:

Hold hearing for approval of documents and conveyance of excess City property located south of and adjoining West Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway and west of and adjoining Southwest 11th Street to HRC NFS I, LLC for \$970,000.

## SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the conveyance of excess City-owned property located south of and adjoining West Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway and west of and adjoining Southwest 11th Street to HRC NFS I, LLC, 6900 Westown Parkway, West Des Moines, IA, 50266, for \$970,000, contingent upon HRC NFS I, LLC providing City with proof of ownership of the adjoining property currently owned by Norfolk Southern Railway. This action is required by Iowa law prior to making a final determination on the proposed sale by resolution.

The sale of the City's property will allow the buyer to assemble the City property with the adjoining land for a proposed redevelopment project. There is no current or anticipated public need for this property, and this conveyance will eliminate future maintenance and liability costs for the City and will return the property to the tax rolls.

## FISCAL IMPACT:



## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

 HRC NFS I, LLC, Dan Cornelison, Senior Vice President, has negotiated with Norfolk Southern Railway an option to purchase the vacant land adjoining the City-owned property located south of and adjoining West Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway and west of and adjoining Southwest 11th Street, and has offered to the City of Des Moines the purchase price of \$970,000.00 for the purchase of the City-owned property located south of and adjoining West Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway and west of and adjoining Southwest 11th Street, contingent upon HRC NFS I, LLC providing City with proof of ownership of the adjoining property currently owned by Norfolk Southern Railway, and subject to the reservation of easements for any and all utilities currently located upon the property, until such time as said utilities are abandoned or relocated at no cost to the City of Des Moines.

- The property to be conveyed consists of approximately 74,270 square feet and the purchase price of \$970,000 is equal to the fair market value of the property, as determined by an independent appraisal.
- There is no current or anticipated public need for this property, and this conveyance will allow the buyer to assemble the City property with the adjoining land for a proposed redevelopment project, eliminate future maintenance and liability costs for the City, and will return the property to the tax rolls.
